Complete Application with attachment reflecting how Average Monthly Payroll was calculated (Note: The final application is dated 9/30/2020 in the top right corner)
Information demonstrating the Applicant had employees for whom the Applicant paid salaries and payroll taxes on or around February 15, 2020
Payroll Documentation for 12 months ending 12/31/2019 Including Applicant paid salaries, payroll taxes, health insurance premiums, and/or retirement benefits
PROVIDE ALL THAT APPLY FROM THE LIST BELOW:  A) Annual 2019 IRS 941 Forms (Quarterly payroll tax return)  B) Include 2019 W-2s for all employees and 2019 W-3  C) If includes "wages" paid as 1099, IRS Form 1096 (Annual Summary and Transmittal of US Information Returns AKA 1099 Payroll Expense)  D) If a sole proprietor, 2019 IRS Form 1040 Schedule C (if not filed, please provide 2019 income statement)  E) Documentation for all health insurance premiums paid by the Applicant under a group health plan, if applicable.  F) Documentation for all retirement plan contributions to employees paid by the Applicant, if applicable.  ***This is an evolving program and changes may occur. The Bank may require tax returns, financial statements, or other documentation if deemed necessary by the SBA.
Copy of Driver's License for 20%+ owners of the organization
If not already on file with Bank, include business formation documents (Examples: Articles of Incorporation, Operating Agreements, Certificate of Formation, etc.)
NAICS Code (Note: May be found on your tax return)
If an agent assisted you with completion of your application, the agent should complete SBA Form 159
